1. Matters Arising from 6 July meeting

1. Carmarthen Road :- LC advised that this scheme has now been shelved because of an inability to meet the 'Trunk Road' specification and provide an adequate Cycle lane.
2. Planning Applications:- Agreed that a Protocol for scrutinising applications should be formalised and this would be best led by Sustrans. **Action LC** to contact and agree Protocol with CCS

2. Kingsway & Proposed CCS Route SW to NE

1. The proposal from CCS of an alternate cycle path whilst not ideal should be supported as it would provide a useful option for cyclists to permeate through the centre. This however should be in addition to the strongly desired 2-way route along the Kingsway not a replacement.

3. Fabian Way & Bay Campus

1. Signage to be erected by contractor. Review ride planned for 30th Sept. NG to feedback any concerns.

4. Input to CCS Cycle Route/Path proposals

1. CW suggested that WR need to be consulted earlier on proposals, ideally at the ideas stage. WR input on the Kingsway consultation was on too late to have any impact on the design and was essentially a critique on what the CCS were planning. This issue to be raised at next CAP meeting.

5. Next Route Group Ride (10am Saturday 3rd October, Civic Centre Cafe)

1. Agreed that ride to focus on City Centre cycle routes.
